LAWFAS – What is it?





- Is a web portal, based on SharePoint, that creates a connected and interactive community of NATO and national legal offices to support, facilitate and improve legal support for the Alliance in its operations and activities;
- LAWFAS has become the only legal tool at the International, Operational and Managerial branches
- Supported and maintained by a team of two people an international lawyer and a SharePoint Administrator;
- Provides the only organized searchable repository of legally significant NATO documents (5,000+ and growing); and
- Transforming the provision and support of NATO legal advice.

LAWFAS – The Three Pillars



The goal of LAWFAS is to capture relevant documents, facilitate document researches and ensure an easy access to all relevant information NATO-wide, as a Repository



LAWFAS is an interactive tool, which provides legal support to NATO and Member States and Universities, acts as a Paralegal On-Line Service



Legal Clinic with the universities (Roma Tre and Paris Pantheon Sorbonne) and research institutions on topics of interest

- Autonomous Weapons and Humanitarian Access in Non-International Armed Conflicts (2018 Roma Tre)

- Theory of Implied Powers in International Organizations and Subsidiary Organs in NATO Operations and Missions (2019 Paris)






Central Repository of International Agreements (CRIA)



- The HQ SACT and SHAPE Legal Offices are the two repositories of international agreements signed by, or on behalf of, HQ SACT, SHAPE, or any constituent element (Bi-SC Directive 15-003 Preparation and Control of International Agreements)
- The Office of the ACO/SHAPE Legal Advisor is currently the custodian of the original versions of international agreements which are in force.
- These documents are stored in CRIA and in LAWFAS





Central Repository of International Agreements (CRIA)



- The Central Repository of International Agreements (CRIA) is located inside the NATO ACO Office of Legal Affairs and LAWFAS Team is responsible for this service.
 - Keep the hard copies of all International Agreements between SHAPE and nations
 - Maintain a digital service of all of these documents
- In CRIA you may find the following documents:
 - MOUs, MOAs, TAs, NOJs, NOAs, MWAs, EOLs, etc.
- Preparing and providing certified true copies is also a task for LAWFAS Team





LAWFAS - RAP



- LAWFAS is part of the NATO Readiness Action Plan (RAP) and considered as a Minimum Military Requirement (MMR);
- LAWFAS is providing support to NATO Force Integration Units (NFIUs), the Multinational Corps North-East (MNC-NE) and the Multinational Division South-East (MND-SE);
- This new concept have led to the creation of new NATO Legal Offices and, consequently, the number of users have been increased;
- Concerning RAP, LAWFAS has been gathering all policy documents;
- Due to the restricted classification of the policy, most of these documents are available on the NATO Secret







LAWFAS - RAP



 The Legal architecture of the RAP comprises more than 2000 legal acts concluded by RAIO in order to enable SACEURs Area of Responsibility for the movement of troops.

Architecture includes:

- SA (Supplementary Agreements) to Paris Protocol (1952)
- HNS (Host Nation Support) MOUs (Memorandum of Understanding)
- VJTF (Very High Readiness Joint Task Forces)
 TAs (Technical Arrangements)
- New HQs founding documents
- Notes of Accession
- Statements of intent

The NSA pursues this mission with two types of standarization documents: Standardization Agreements (STANAGs) and Allied Publications (APs).

ACCESS TO LAWFAS NATO Secret Network

- If you are member of a NATO Country, you have a NATO Security Clearance and you have a NATO Secret account
 - You can have access to LAWFAS
 - Contact LAWFAS Administrator
 - <u>Jose.dasilvamiguel@shape.nato.int</u> request for access
 - Per our request, NATO Office Security (NOS) can also create an account for users who do not belong to NATO HQ (Minerva Domain) or to SHAPE (AIS Domain)
 - For these requests is necessary a copy of your security clearance and some paperwork signed
- Once the access is granted or the account is created, go to:
 - https://lawfas.hq.nato.int
 - Once there, choose:
 - NATO Command Structure (AIS), for SHAPE
 - NATO HQ (MINERVA or Athena (N950) account), for NATO HQ
